We are into the final stretch of the season. At this time we will be running hunts through Saturday April 4th, with what ever birds are left. At the moment we were able to purchase more quail so we should have plenty of quail and pheasant to get through the end of season.

The last two tower shoots went off well with both being within a couple of shooters of being full. At this time we are planning on two more. The first will be on Sunday March 22nd, and the final clean the pen shoot will be on Saturday April 4th. Details are listed below.

Field hunts are going well and hopefully we can keep getting a few cool fronts to keep the temperature in check. It is starting to green up a bit and it also is that time of year when the birds are starting to breed. Whenever this happens, quality tends to take a dive and also the hens start to loose their scent. This is just natures way, how else could a bird nest on the ground and survive. To off set this we release in small coveys instead of singles an doubles and we will also be releasing a few extra birds with each hunt.

Pricing and membership information for the 2020 - 2021 season will be updated on the website by the end of the month. We will be having a few small price increases to offset continued rise in expenses. Once again, memberships will be discounted for next season if purchased prior to June 1. The will be no discounts beyond this date.
